A Pivotal Moment in Our Story.

1964

Thirteen local families establish Westminster Chapel, meeting in downtown Bellevue.

1969

A-frame chapel and education building completed at our current location; 500 members gather for two Sunday services.

2004

Next Chapter campaign launched to fund a major expansion, replacing the original chapel with a three-story Community Life Center housing NextGen spaces, offices, classrooms, and counseling center.

2020

Pastor Ryan Falls begins ministry at Westminster, launching a renewed focus on reaching emerging generations, strengthening discipleship pathways, and preparing the church for future growth.

2025

RISE Campaign launches — Westminster's first campus-wide renovation in 20 years, positioning us to serve the next generation.
